17. INSURANCE

By endorsing the application form for entry, the FMN of the driver/passenger/rider, certifies that the driver/passenger/rider is insured in accordance with the FIM requirements.

The organiser has contracted a third party insurance in accordance with Art. 110.1 of the FIM Sporting Code.

This insurance includes a guarantee of 5'000'000 CHF(local currency).

The organiser disclaims all responsibility for damage to a motorcycle, its accessories and components arising out of an accident, fire or other incident.

18. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

Any person or group of persons (driver, passenger, rider, entrant, manufacturer, official, etc.), recognised by the FIM and concerned by a decision taken under the authority of the FIM, may ask for redress for the consequences of that decision.

Protests must be lodged according to the FIM Disciplinary and Arbitration Code and the Supplementary Regulations and be accompanied by a fee of US\$ 800.- (€ 640.-) or the equivalent amount in local currency, returnable if the protest is justified.

Generally, protests against the eligibility of a driver, passenger, rider, entrant or a motorcycle entered, must be made before the start of the official practice.

Protests against results must be presented to the International Jury within 30 minutes following the announcement of the results.

An appeal may be made against a decision of the International Jury to the International Disciplinary Court (CDI).

If the protest entails dismantling a motorcycle, the protest fee must be accompanied by an additional deposit of US\$ 150.- (€ 120.-). This fee must be paid by the losing party to the mechanic of the driver who had to open the engine

Protests entailing a fuel control must be accompanied by an additional deposit of US\$ 1'000.- (€ 800.-).
